ISO/IEC 27001:2022 - what are the changes?

ISO/IEC 27001:2022, the international standard for information security management systems (ISMS), was updated in October of 2022 to reflect the latest developments in the field of cybersecurity. These changes are aimed at helping organizations better manage their information security risks and protect their sensitive data.

The majority of changes to the standard were in the Annex A controls which went through a re-structuring to include a change to how the controls were organized and the controls in total were reduced from 114 to 93. Of the old 114 controls
